10 THAT THIS HAPPENED ON MAY 18TH?

11 A BECAUSE I CHECKED THE CALENDAR AND REMEMBERED  
12 IT, WHAT DAY IT WAS.

13 Q BESIDES CHECKING THE CALENDAR, HOW DID YOU  
14 REMEMBER?

15 A WELL, I REMEMBERED THAT DETECTIVE ROACH WAS  
16 SAYING IT.

17 Q OKAY. ALL RIGHT. DO YOU REMEMBER US TALKING  
18 THEN LAST TIME, RIGHT?

19 A YES.

20 Q AND I ASKED YOU SOME QUESTIONS AND YOU GAVE ME  
21 ANSWERS, RIGHT?

22 A HMM-HMM.

24 OKAY?

11 A WHO?

12 Q WHOEVER IT WAS THAT CAME INTO THE HOUSE. YOU SAID  
13 IT WAS SCOTTY?

14 A YES.

15 Q YOU DID HEAR HIM COME INTO THE HOUSE?

16 A NO, I DIDN'T HEAR HIM COME INTO THE HOUSE.

17 Q YOU DIDN'T HEAR HIM COME INTO THE BEDROOM, EITHER,  
18 DID YOU?

19 A NO.

20 Q YOU DIDN'T SEE SCOTTY TOUCH MICHELLE AT ALL,  
21 DID YOU?

22 A HE WAS WHISPERING TO HER, SO HE WAS GOING LIKE  
23 THIS -- (INDICATING).

24 Q YOU DIDN'T SEE HIS HAND GO OVER HER MOUTH AT  
25 ALL, DID YOU?

1 A NO, I DIDN'T SEE IT.

2 Q YOU SAID THAT SCOTTY WAS TALKING TO YOUR SISTER?

3 A (NODS HEAD)

4 Q AND WHAT WERE YOU DOING AT THAT TIME? YOU WERE  
5 SLEEPING?

6 A YES, SLEEPING. ✓

7 Q AND WHEN YOU SAID SCOTTY COME OVER TO YOUR SIDE  
8 OF THE BED, YOUR SISTER WAS SLEEPING, RIGHT?

9 A NO, SHE WASN'T SLEEPING. SHE WAS AWAKE.

10 Q BUT SHE SAID SHE WAS PRETENDING TO BE ASLEEP?

11 A YES.

12 Q SHE WAS LAYING ON HER SIDE --

13 A YES.

14 Q -- AT THAT TIME, WITH HER BACK TO YOU, RIGHT?

15 A YES.

16 Q AND SCOTTY DIDN'T HURT YOU, DID HE?

17 A NO.

18 Q HE DIDN'T HURT YOU AT ALL?

19 A (SHAKES HEAD)

20 Q AT THIS TIME YOUR SISTER HAD A SHEET ON HER,  
21 DIDN'T SHE?

22 A YES.

23 Q AND IT WAS KIND OF COVERING HER ALL UP, WASN'T IT?

24 A YES.

1 THE YARD?

2 A (SHAKES HEAD)

3 Q YOU DON'T KNOW WHICH DOOR HE WENT OUT, DO YOU?

4 A NOT FOR SURE, NO.

5 Q YOU DON'T KNOW IF HE WENT OUT A WINDOW?

6 A NO.

7 Q YOU DIDN'T HEAR A DOOR OR WINDOW CLOSE AT ALL,  
8 DID YOU?

9 A NO.

10 Q YOU HAVE A COUPLE OF WINDOWS IN YOUR BEDROOM,  
11 DON'T YOU?

12 A YES.

13 Q YOU DIDN'T LOOK OUT THOSE WINDOWS, THOUGH, DID  
14 YOU?

15 A NO.

16 Q ALL RIGHT. WHEN YOU WENT TO SEE YOUR GRANDFATHER
