6 Q I'M SORRY. ON MAY 18TH?

7 A YES.

8 Q THEY SAID NOTHING TO YOU AT SEVEN O'CLOCK?

9 A WELL, THEY WERE WAKING UP AND CLIMBING OUT OF BED.
10 AND NO, THEY DIDN'T SAY ANYTHING AT THAT TIME BECAUSE I
11 ALWAYS TURN AROUND AND LEAVE.

12 Q THEY DIDN'T SAY ANYTHING TO YOU ABOUT WHETHER
13 SCOTTY HAD BEEN THERE, OR NOT?

14 A NO, NOT UNTIL I GOT OUT OF THE SHOWER.

15 Q ISN'T IT TRUE THAT YOU FOUND THAT BOTH OF YOUR
16 KIDS HAD LIED BEFORE?

17 A IN WHAT CONTEXT?

18 Q BOTH YOUR CHILDREN, ANGELA AND MICHELLE, HAVE
19 TOLD YOU LIES BEFORE, JUST SOME TYPE OF LIE?

20 A AS THEY'VE LEARNED THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE
21 RIGHT AND WRONG, YES.

22 Q WHEN YOU DROVE THEM TO SCHOOL THEY DIDN'T SAY
23 ANYTHING ELSE ABOUT SCOTTY BEING THERE?

24 A ON THE WAY TO SCHOOL?

25 Q ON THE WAY TO SCHOOL?

1 A FROM THE TIME THEY TALKED TO ME UNTIL I DROPPED
2 THEM OFF AT SCHOOL THEY TALKED ABOUT IT.

3 Q THEY DIDN'T SAY ANYTHING ABOUT SCOTTY MOLESTING
4 ANGELA AT ALL?

5 A NO. BECAUSE AT THAT POINT IN TIME THEY WERE TOO
6 AFRAID TO LEAVE ME, AT HOME.

7 MR. EIDE: YOUR HONOR, I WOULD ASK THAT THAT BE
8 STRICKEN AS NON-RESPONSIVE AND SPECULATION.

9 SHE DOESN'T KNOW WHY THEY DIDN'T TELL HER.
10 THE FACT IS THEY DID NOT TELL HER.

11 THE COURT: READ BACK THE RESPONSE.

12 (THEREUPON, COUNSEL APPROACHED THE BENCH, AND THE
13 FOLLOWING PROCEEDINGS WERE HAD OUTSIDE THE HEARING OF THE
14 JURY, AND ON THE RECORD AS FOLLOWS:)

15 THE COURT: READ IT BACK.

16 (THEREUPON, THE LAST QUESTION AND ANSWER WERE READ
17 BACK BY THE COURT REPORTER.)

18 MR. EIDE: SHE HAS NO IDEA --

19 THE COURT: ALL RIGHT. MOTION TO STRIKE WILL
20 BE GRANTED.

21 (THEREUPON, THE SIDE-BAR CONFERENCE WAS CONCLUDED.)

22 THE COURT: LADIES AND GENTLEMEN OF THE JURY,
23 YOU ARE TO DISREGARD THE RESPONSE AS TO WHY THE
24 CHILDREN DID NOT TELL HER, THE STATEMENT.

25 BY MR. EIDE:

1 Q YOU SAID YOU WENT OUT TO BED ABOUT 11:00 O'CLOCK?

2 A APPROXIMATELY, YES.

3 Q DO YOU REMEMBER WHO WAS IN THE HOUSE AT THE TIME
4 YOU LEFT?

5 A MY MOM AND MY DAD, MY NEPHEW AND MY TWO LITTLE
6 GIRLS.

7 Q DO YOU KNOW IF ANY OF THE PEOPLE LEFT, AT ALL,
8 IN THE MIDDLE OF THE NIGHT?

9 A NOT THAT I'M AWARE OF.

10 Q COULD SOMEONE HAVE LEFT THE HOUSE AND COME BACK
11 IN THE MIDDLE OF THE NIGHT WITHOUT YOU KNOWING IT?

12 A YES.

13 Q THE SCHOOL THAT THEY GO TO IS PRINCETON ELEMENTARY?

14 A CORRECT.

15 Q THAT'S ABOUT WHAT THREE BLOCKS, TWO OR THREE BLOCKS
16 FROM YOUR HOUSE?

17 A APPROXIMATELY.

18 Q HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE YOU TO DRIVE THERE?

19 A PROBABLY A MINUTE.

20 MR. EIDE: OKAY. I HAVE NO OTHER QUESTIONS,

21 YOUR HONOR.

22 THE COURT: REDIRECT?

23 MR. BENDER: YES, SIR.
