20 THE CLERK: JUROR NUMBER THREE, ARE THESE YOUR  
21 VERDICTS?

22 JUROR NUMBER THREE: YES.

23 THE CLERK: JUROR NUMBER FOUR, ARE THESE YOUR  
24 VERDICTS?

25 JUROR NUMBER FOUR: YES.

1 THE CLERK: JUROR NUMBER FIVE, ARE THESE YOUR  
2 VERDICTS?

3 JUROR NUMBER FIVE: YES.

4 THE CLERK: JUROR NUMBER SIX, ARE THESE YOUR  
5 VERDICTS?

6 JUROR NUMBER SIX: YES.

7 THE COURT: REMOVE THOSE PEOPLE FROM THIS FLOOR  
8 BEFORE I HOLD THEM IN CONTEMPT.

9 LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, I WISH TO THANK YOU  
10 FOR YOUR TIME AND CONSIDERATION IN THIS CASE. I ALSO  
11 WISH TO ADVISE YOU OF SOME VERY SPECIAL PRIVILEGES  
12 ENJOYED BY JURORS.

13 NO JUROR CAN EVER BE REQUIRED TO TALK ABOUT  
14 THE DISCUSSIONS THAT OCCURRED IN THE JURY ROOM, EXCEPT  
15 BY COURT ORDER.

16 FOR MANY CENTURIES OUR SOCIETY HAS RELIED  
17 UPON JURIES FOR CONSIDERATION OF DIFFICULT CASES. WE  
18 HAVE RECOGNIZED FOR HUNDREDS OF YEARS THAT A JURY'S  
19 DELIBERATIONS, DISCUSSIONS AND VOTES SHOULD REMAIN  
20 THEIR PRIVATE AFFAIR AS LONG AS THEY WISH IT.

21 THEREFORE, THE LAW GIVES YOU A UNIQUE  
22 PRIVILEGE NOT TO SPEAK ABOUT ABOUT THE JURY'S WORK.  
23 ALTHOUGH YOU ARE AT LIBERTY TO SPEAK WITH ANYONE ABOUT  
24 YOUR DELIBERATIONS, YOU ARE ALSO AT LIBERTY TO REFUSE  
25 TO SPEAK TO ANYONE.
