2 THANK YOU, SIR.

3 MR. EIDE: A COUPLE OF QUESTIONS, YOUR HONOR.

4 REDIRECT EXAMINATION

5 BY MR. EIDE:

6 Q MR. WILLEY, DO YOU REMEMBER THE OFFICER TALKING  
7 TO YOU ABOUT THE CARS THERE AT THE TRAILER?

8 A YES, I DO.

9 Q DO YOU REMEMBER HIM ASKING YOU ABOUT WHETHER  
10 ANY OF THE VEHICLES WERE ACCESSIBLE?

11 A YES.

12 Q WHAT DID HE ASK YOU?

13 A HE ASKED ME IF THERE WAS ANY WAY TO GET ANY OF  
14 THE CARS OUT. AND AT THAT TIME MY BROTHER'S WAS BROKE,  
15 AND I HAD MY KEYS.

16 Q WAS THERE ANY OTHER CARS THERE?

17 A MY SISTER HAS A CAR. BUT MY MOM HAD IT UNTIL,  
18 LIKE, MIDNIGHT.

19 Q DO YOU HAVE ANY IDEA IF SCOTTY HAD ACCESS TO  
20 THOSE KEYS, IN YOUR OWN KNOWLEDGE?

21 A NOT THAT I KNOW OF.

22 Q DID THE OFFICER ASK YOU ANYTHING ELSE ABOUT THE  
23 CARS?

24 A NO.

25 MR. EIDE: NO OTHER QUESTIONS, YOUR HONOR.

1 THE COURT: RECROSS?

2 MR. BENDER: NO, YOUR HONOR.

3 THE COURT: YOU MAY STEP DOWN.

4 CALL YOUR NEXT WITNESS.

5 MR. EIDE: YOUR HONOR, COULD WE APPROACH?

6 (THEREUPON, COUNSEL APPROACHED THE BENCH, AND THE  
7 FOLLOWING PROCEEDINGS WERE HAD OUTSIDE THE HEARING OF THE  
8 JURY, AND ON THE RECORD AS FOLLOWS:)

9 MR. EIDE: YOUR HONOR, AT THIS TIME I WANT TO  
10 CALL A WITNESS, AND I NEED TO MAKE A MOTION IN LIMINE  
11 REGARDING QUESTIONING FROM THE STATE AS TO POSSIBLE  
12 PRIOR CONVICTIONS.

13 AND I BELIEVE THERE'S CASE LAW SAYING,  
14 FIRST OF ALL, WE HAVE TO BE PROVIDED WITH J AND S'S  
15 AS TO THE CONVICTIONS.

16 THE COURT: IS THIS YOUR WITNESS?

17 MR. EIDE: YES, IT IS.

18 THE COURT: WHEN DID YOU FURNISH HIM WITH THAT?

19 MR. EIDE: A LONG TIME AGO.

20 AND, SECONDLY, EVEN IF THEY DID FURNISH  
21 IT, THEY COULD NOT USE A CRIME WHERE AN ADJUDICATION  
22 WAS WITHHELD. AND SO I WOULD LIKE TO MOVE IN LIMINE  
23 THAT THE STATE NOT --
